The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code 2016 is a Landmark piece of consolidated Single Law/Legislation, which has overhauled our country's Insolvency & Bankruptcy. As such we can say that these Insolvency & Bankruptcy have been consolidated and brought under Single umbrella and now it is understood that the speed of its implementation by the Present govt. is commendable. There is a total shift in process of handling through legislative amendments, and also setting up of regulatory bodies such as IBBI, issuance of regulations and model bye-laws that govern Insolvency Resolution Professionals and certain laid down mechanism for transitioning from the existing Laws e.g. Companies Act 1956, the Presidency Towns Insolvency Act, 1909, the Provincial Insolvency Act 1920, the Industrial Companies Act 1985.

2. Er. Madan Mohan, Former Member SCC UP State Centre & Former Chairman Ghaziabad Local Centre passed away in February 2019.


Members of UP State Centre expressed grief at the demise of above mentioned Members & Pray almighty to rest their sole in peace.
